

The First Vial Checklist

10 checks before you buy a single milligram. For women who research carefully.



Every vendor we list on Peptide Price Lab passes the same four-part vetting, lab-tested COAs, an independent quality grade, domain history, and real community reviews, not just the lowest price. **This is that standard, in your hands.**

START SMART

- ☐ **Name why you're researching this peptide** and the one result you'd measure. If you can't, you're not ready to spend yet.
- ☐ **Read one plain-language summary of the research** and note how many human trials exist. For a lot of peptides that number is small or zero, and it's worth knowing before you buy.
- ☐ **Keep the legal reality in view.** These are research compounds, not medications, and no vendor's product is approved for human use.

DO THE MATH

- ☐ **Price by the milligram, not by the vial.** A \$28 5 mg vial costs more per mg than a \$45 10 mg vial, every time.
- ☐ **Compare that per-mg price across at least three vendors**, and fold shipping into small orders before you call anything a deal.
- ☐ **Check bundles by the milligram too**, since a bundle can quietly cost more instead of less.

VET THE VENDOR

- ☐ **Find the certificate of analysis, the COA**, for your exact batch, not a generic one. No COA, no order.
- ☐ **Check that COA is from a third-party lab you can look up**, and that it's dated within the last year.
- ☐ **Look for 98% purity or higher by HPLC.** "Pharmaceutical grade" is a marketing phrase, not a measurement.
- ☐ **Search the vendor's name with "reviews"** somewhere other than their own site. Forums and Reddit count; homepage testimonials don't.

ONE LAST THING

Order the small size first, even if the math favors the big vial. Your first order from any vendor is a test of the vendor, not a place to stock up. Peptides ship as a dried powder, so you'll also need bacteriostatic water, the sterile water you mix them with to turn the powder into liquid. If you don't have it, add it to the same order, since every vendor sells it. Basic supplies like syringes are easy to find on Amazon.
